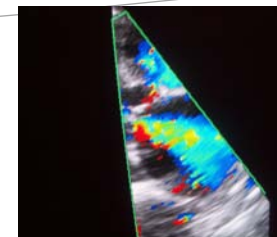
Client Expectations



Chemotherapy

We will evaluate all information from your veterinarian and obtain a detailed history of your pet's condition and current treatments. You will remain with your pet during the physical examination and throughout many of the additional procedures that we feel are necessary for a comprehensive diagnosis. Some procedures, especially those requiring sedation or general anesthesia, may require you to schedule a second visit.

A comprehensive medical summary will be sent to your veterinarian within days of your pet's visit. We will work with your veterinarian for follow up on your pet's care which may include future laboratory tests or other diagnostic procedures.
